



Dear Parents,

We are delighted to welcome your child in our school for the next school year.

**Your child will start school on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020 in La Petite Ecole Bilingue - Kentish Town.**

Given the ongoing sanitary crisis and, that the Department for Education requirements and guidelines are modified on a daily basis, this first day at school has been drawn taking into account the latest DfE recommendations available to date. We expect to be allowed and able to resume lessons for all and all week as we have done since 01/06/2020. An updated school COVID 19 protocol and organisation, and a compulsory questionnaire will be emailed to families a few days prior 02/09/2020.

First day at school times will be as follow:

8.40am	Y2 + Y3/4
8.55am	REC + Y1
9.10am	NURS
12.00pm	End of day for all year groups

On this first day at school, **all pupils will have to be collected at 12pm.**

School will take place at the usual times for everybody as soon as the 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2020: 8.45am lessons start, 4.05pm end of lessons for the last year group (cf. ANNEX 1). (NB: provided the DfE is allowing schools to resume for all age groups at the same time).

The content of the school bag is bought by the school and given to pupils on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school. Textbooks are lent by the school for the school year. ANNEX 2 is detailing the supplies to be bought by families and ANNEX 3 is detailing the compulsory elements of the school uniform as well as the uniform provider (see att. September Important date doc. for the Uniforms sale date).

**Before we can meet in September, the school requires parents to fill in the [2020/2021 BACK TO SCHOOL QUESTIONNAIRE \(one per child\) by Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2020.](#)** We do acknowledge the fact that some of you are in the process of moving homes and that your files will need to be updated, but it is a compulsory requirement for schools to hold these paramount details before the start of the school year.

Last thing: a list of important dates at school is available among the attached documents. (cf. September 2020 important dates)

The school is now closing for the summer; we will be back at the office on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020.** In the meantime, we will monitor incoming emails but expect a delay in the treatment of files during the holidays.
